The Components of My Path to "Enlightenment"

Developing significant visualization skills in childhood; scrambling in high school to acquire increased reading competence; developing independent critical

thinking skills in my college English literature major; learning the research process in my masters in English literature; teaching composition at the college level and simplifying my own writing; pursuing a doctorate studying traditional art, anthropology, linguistics, and American sign language; writing a dissertation on the diversity of psychological function of individual items of expressive culture; teaching a huge range of courses in the PhD program in traditional art at the University of Pennsylvania; exploring the significance of personality, developmental, cognitive, evolutionary, and paranormal psychology for understanding art; being made aware of the core religious experience while conducting ten years of field research in an urban black church community; being personally introduced to meditation; exploring research on paranormal, creativity and inspiration that leads to the concept of intuitive competence; conducting five years of field research with a psychic healer that demonstrates the practical importance of intuitive mental modes; developing the unification perspective on reality; developing the worldview tool of the materialspiritual continuum; recognizing the paranormal as the bridge between the material and the spiritual perspectives on reality; recognizing the limitation of the rational, secular material perspective in defining reality; recognizing the "spiritual" source and function of art and ritual in human reality; recognizing the critical role of language in defining the human perception of reality; developing the dynamic humanism worldview; recognizing the relevant confirming discoveries in physics and cosmology; discovering the parallel reality principles in quantum mechanics; appreciating the significance of relativity theory and the matter and energy interchange; recognizing energy as primary in the origination of reality in the big bang; appreciating the importance of the universe expanding and the depth of the unknown in dark matter and dark energy; recognizing the total integration and unification basis of both energy and matter in reality; appreciating the role of human perceptual limitations in the human conception of reality; realizing the human assumptions of separation and free will as illusions that large scale system flexibility tolerates; recognizing that all organic species on Earth - including humans - have evolved successfully within this illusion; recognizing the two realities: the real one - total unification of a vast, open reality system and the illusory one - a system flexible enough to tolerate the illusion of separation and free will; recognizing that humans are encountering Earth system limits for the first time in the climate change phenomenon; appreciating the need for humans to adopt a responsible, balanced dynamic perspective on reality to succeed as a species; and highlighting the importance of the art-ritual function in human society to connect humans through their intuitive competence to the unification experience and awareness of reality.
