

# Penetrating the Energy Mystery

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From the material perspective, everything is composed of separate, lesser “things” [particles, atoms, molecules, etc.] which combine to form larger or greater “things” through the process of cause and effect over time. But, the material/physical domain of reality – to which we attach such importance – is less than 5% of reality. By contrast, our present understanding is that immaterial energy is at least 70% of reality, and it is pervasive all the time at every scale of reality from the “vacuum” of space, to atoms, to rocks to planets to galaxies, etc.

So, of what is immaterial energy composed – fields and waves? Is the field condition primary? Energy fields exist at all scales; so, how are fields connected/integrated at all scales to form the unification web of reality as a whole? How does the nature of energy provide the explanation for change as the only constant in reality?

We carve out different “forms” of energy [electromagnetic, kinetic, gravitational, etc]. We assert that energy is primary in reality [Big Bang Theory] and that energy can secondarily evolve to become matter through the process of tiny energy fields [“particles”] somehow acquiring mass [Higgs boson particle], but the realm of energy itself remains mostly a mystery.

At present, energy simply IS – a primary construct like the “God” of all creation!

When will we start investigating the fundamental nature of energy and stop assuming that our conception of the 5% of reality with which we identify provides the basis to account for reality as a whole? Quantum Theory identifies some of the features of an integrated, energy-field based reality [eg. entanglement], but it persists in a commitment to the material principle of separation in the basic components of reality that it proposes. Intellect and the language based analytical process of science rest on the assumptions of constants, separation and thingness – fundamental to the material perspective; so, our basic tools of investigation may well be inappropriate to the task. Will we pursue the alternative option and try to create a rigorous process of discovery through our more synthetically oriented, visual, intuitive faculty [insight, inspiration]?
