- 4) The human creative process which relies heavily on synthesis promoted by visual thinking associated with the Intuitive in contrast to analysis promoted by language based thought associated with the Intellect,
- 5) The universal presence in human societies of all “paranormal” phenomena – telepathy, clairvoyance, precognition and psychokinesis – viewed from the material perspective of separation as “impossible miracles,”
- 6) The function of art-ritual in human societies as the major behavioral vehicles carrying individuals and human groups first to the realization and ultimately to the experience of unification,
- 7) The underlying factor motivating human commitment to cooperative/egalitarian social behavior – the WE rather than the ME perspective as confirmed at the hereditary level by socio-biology,
- 8) The spiritual perspective – not to be confused with religion.
