

# Where Do I Go From Here?

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In my 85<sup>th</sup> year and during a deep TIA [transient ischemic attack], I encountered the point of “letting go.” I lost most language capability for a day and my personality became unpredictable. I could not understand what was going on in the context of my emergency room treatment. My vision was present, but all I could see was the hall lights switch locations as I was wheeled through the corridors – switch after switch until I asked myself if it was time to “give it up.” I don’t know what would have happened if I had done so, but I came close.

This experience brings to the foreground of my contemplating the question, “Where do I go from here?” The mystery of Death is at a minimum the absence of cognitive presence. Is this just the equivalent of deep sleep in which we are totally unaware cognitively of our existence? We invite this all the time!

From the material perspective, I am a separate/discrete entity, but as an immaterial energy field phenomenon I am infinitely connected to all other energy in reality. And my energy field is always in a state of change along with all else. So, is there a final change – death, or merely perpetual change? We think of our cognitive awareness as “who we are,” but that awareness is absent in deep sleep for much of our life. Where is this unique, independent ME? Or is my uniqueness/separateness a pervasive illusion of the material perspective?

Maybe there is no more uncertainty in what we call death than there is in my inviting the significant benefits of deep sleep!

I will not rely on prophets or saviors to somehow rescue me at the “pearly gates.” And this energy “religion” is totally inclusive, dissolving the basis for all the warring among the groups connected to our highly competitive religions!
