Recommendations:

- 1) Under our human cultural umbrella where the artificial categories of language define our reality, Hate the fact that to a significant degree we live a manufactured worldview “fiction.”
- 2) Accept/Love the fact that only with commitment to such a mutually held worldview can we achieve the cooperation necessary to manage our communities, states, and nations.
- 3) While recognizing this Paradox and its underlying source, we can Nevertheless always strive to achieve a more encompassing, accurate and responsible worldview. In this regard,
 - a. We could release our obsession with the material domain of reality and focus on the 70 – 95% of reality that is immaterial energy.
 - b. We could explore the human energy field [aura] in relation to health, social relations and the infinite, interconnected energy web of the cosmos.
 - c. We could discover that our immaterial energy field IS Consciousness.
 - d. We could discover that we can employ our energy field [consciousness] to navigate reality trans-dimensionally and inter-dimensionally and thereby transcend the material limitations of space and time, ie. space-time travel.
 - e. We could Love our Collective future and discard the need for Hate!
